HORVÁTH László

Preparing the critical edition of the Greek text of Codex Ivron 463 (*Barlaam and Josaphat*) for the press, as a supplement to the Old French translation edited by Emese Egedi-Kovács, projected for future publication.

Comprehensive examination and textual edition of Ἰππότης ὁ πρεσβύτερος (*The Old Knight*), the only mediaeval Greek branching-off of the Breton sagas.



EGEDI-KOVÁCS

Transcription and critical edition of the Greek and Old French texts of the Byzantine codex Mount Athos: Ivron 463. The main text of the 11th-c. Greek manuscript is an abridged version of the romance legend *Barlaam and Josaphat* in Ancient Greek. The chief interest concerning the manuscript lies in the fact that adjacent to, and around, the Greek text, on the margins, all through the 135 folios, it includes a presumably very old translation in Old French (probably from the 12th c.), which has not been substantially researched, nor known or published, up until the

MÉSZÁROS Tamás

Preparations for a new critical edition of Laonikos Chalkokondyles' *Histories*

The work can contribute several partial results to (1) a new edition of Laonikos Chalkokondyles' *Histories* in accordance with the principles of modern textual criticism. Scientific novelties can be expected mostly in connection with the textual tradition (the examination of previously neglected manuscripts, suggestions concerning different readings), and

We wish to examine (2) the textual connections between Laonikos and his literary models (Thucydides), which can also throw a light on (3) the practice, manner and aim of the treatment of sources in late Byzantine historiography. The Byzantine studies in Hungary, having a long-established tradition, may benefit from the results of (4) the Laonikos research in relation to Hungarian history, in the course of which we may also expect (5) a Laonikos translation with excerpts.



KOVÁCS István

He is studying a codex (Harley 5735) from the second half of the 14th c. written in ancient Greek and containing rhetorical exercises, mostly epistolary models. A part of the MS consists of letters by Libanius, with interlinear glosses. The codex was probably used as a textbook, the cultural background of which is

also in the focus of his research

ADORJÁNI Mária

The NBÖ MS *Suppl. Gr. 182* incorporates two independent exegetic fragments related to the New Testament (Lc 22:7-15; Mc 14:13; Mt 21:23 etc.). Currently she is investigating how the text of the first fragment is connected to Question 3 in *Quaestiones ad Thalassium* by Maximus the Confessor.



TÓTH Iván

Area of research:

Greek and Byzantine historiography

Currently he is working on the new Hungarian translation of and historical commentary on *Syngraphe historion* by Kritoboulos.





MAYER Gyula

Preparing the critical edition of the works of Janus Pannonius, the great 15th-c. humanist. The two existing volumes and the third, projected for next year, include the original Latin works by the poet, while the fourth volume will present his translations from Greek in a bilingual edition, with the reconstruction of the Greek texts used by Janus Pannonius on facing pages.
