

Memorandum of Understanding between
the Byzantium Centre – ELTE Eötvös József Collegium
and
the Centre for Ancient Rhetoric and Drama – University of Peloponnese

I. The Byzantium Centre – ELTE Eötvös József Collegium, Budapest and the Centre for Ancient Rhetoric and Drama – University of Peloponnese (hereafter referred to as Institutions) agree to develop and implement a programme of cooperation in education and research in the field of humanities to include the following:

- mutual visits of the Institutions,
- the sharing of information and publications,
- a joint participation in research, development and associated conferences.

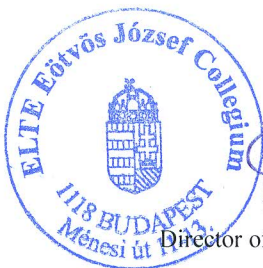
II. Each item of cooperation is to be discussed and agreed upon in advance, to determine the details and conditions for a plan of action.
